



Daily Orientation

Step 1: Thank you for volunteering! Your children, the staff and the entire student body will be blessed by your presence today. At the end of the day, whether you feel like you've done a lot or a little, the impact you'll have on lives today will be huge!

Step 2: Daddy Dos and Daddy Don'ts

- **Be approachable:** smile, talk to the children, listen to them
- **Be alert:** if a situation arises, please report it to a school official starting with the principal
- **Be available:** the goal is to be of service to the school, teachers and students
- **Be flexible:** things change quickly and often when working with children. Go with the flow if the schedule detours and feel to ask a staff member for direction if you need help. If you run into any "down time," feel free to tackle items on the "Can Do Checklist."
- **Just be:** yourself today dad. It's your strength, your personality, your presence that will bless students and staff today—whether you realize it or not.
- **Be a positive role model:**
 - Never use the student (boys' or girls') restrooms. Always use the staff restroom located near the staff lounge.
 - Never be alone with a student (always be visible to others).
 - Do not be disruptive when classes are in session.
 - Do not use profanity.
 - Do not tobacco on the school grounds.
 - Do not sell or give your official WATCH D.O.G.S.® T-shirt to someone who isn't an approved WatchDOG volunteer.
 - Do not use the school environment to solicit a product or company you sell/represent.
